



Dale and Shirley McNeill started in prison and jail ministry in 1992 with the Christian Motorcyclists

Association, taking motorcycles into prisons with Bill Glass Prison Ministry from Texas.

After this experience, God placed a call on their lives to go into prisons and jails to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ and His love for the inmates.

They have ministered to inmates at weekend events with Bill Glass Prison Ministry, Prison Fellowship, Christian Motorcyclists Association and Salvation Army.

They have a team of people who ministered with them at Municipal Correctional Institution (Kansas City jail) for 19 years and Integrity Correctional Centers until it closed in 2010. Jackson County took over Kansas City jail and moved the inmates to a jail downtown. The team now ministers there.

While ministering at Kansas City Municipal Correctional Institution for several years, they became aware that about 85% of the inmates were repeats.

The Lord gave Shirley the vision to have a home for women when released from jail. Some are homeless and others return to situations that are abusive, compelling them to go back to their old ways. Therefore Dale and Shirley have formed The Shepherd's Way Ministries, Inc., a nonprofit corporation to help these women and to continue ministry to both men and women in jail.

The success of The Shepherd's Way Ministries will be made possible by prayer and support of churches, individuals, businesses, and foundations who are committed to helping men and women find freedom from their bondage and live a life to help make our society a better place to live.
